Residential Camp Information

CHECK-IN: Resident campers check-in on Sunday, June 19, 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. on the ORU campus. Exact location will be mailed prior to camp date.

CHECK-OUT: Campers check-out on Thursday, June 23, between 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. from dormitories.

KEY DEPOSIT: All resident campers are required to pay a \$20 room key deposit at check-in. The deposit will be refunded when the key is returned at checkout.

COMMUTERS: Check-in begins Sunday, June 19 at 1:00 p.m. There will be a camp session on Sunday following check-in. Each of the following days, camp begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at approximately 8:30 p.m.

WHAT TO BRING: A detailed list of the necessary items that should be brought to camp will be mailed along with the Residential Camp confirmation letter.

DISCOUNTS: Register with a family member or a friend and each player receives a \$10 discount. Teams (five or more players) registering together receive a \$15 discount per player. Register by May 31, 2011 and receive an additional \$5 discount on each camper.

PAYMENT: Tuition includes 4 nights lodging, 11 meals (Sunday dinner - Thursday breakfast), professional instruction, secondary (back-up) medical insurance, soccer ball and T-shirt. Important: A \$100 nonrefundable deposit is required with each registration. The balance is due at check-in. NO REFUNDS.

THE PROGRAM: Residential camp is specifically for players who want to compete at a higher level. This program focuses on positional play, team tactics and fine-tuning technical skills. We work to give the players a deeper understanding of the game, so they know how, why and when to react on the field.

Our staff makes sure each child receives one-on-one attention, and provides supervision, 24 hours a day, throughout the entire program.

Camp participants will be grouped by age/ability with a player-to-coach ratio of 10:1. Upon completion of the camp, each player will receive a hand-stitched soccer ball and an official camp T-shirt.

FACILITIES: Campers and coaches will be housed in an air-conditioned dormitory on the campus of Oral Roberts University. Meals (all you can eat) will be eaten in the student dining facility - three times per day. The camp staff will closely supervise all soccer and social activities. Soccer training will be held on the ORU soccer fields. The ORU aerobics center will be available for our use. This first-class facility includes a full training room, indoor swimming pool, racquetball and squash courts, and indoor running track and basketball courts. A professional staff is on site at all times.

STAFF: Our knowledgeable staff brings their experience from around the world to ensure top quality training and motivation.

GOALKEEPER

A talented staff of goalkeeper coaches will provide top quality instruction covering such aspects of goalkeeping as foot work, vertical jump, catching, low diving, power diving, boxing, deflecting, angle play, distribution, psychology of goalkeeping, etc.

Because of the special demands of the goalkeeper, these players will be trained separately. Goalkeepers will join teams for selected games and scrimmages.



Day Camp Information

COST: For only \$125 each player will receive professional instruction along with an official camp ball and T-shirt.

DISCOUNTS: To receive a discount, register at the same time with five or more players and each camper receives a \$15 discount.

WHO MAY ATTEND: Girls and boys, ages 5 to 17 may attend. Campers will be grouped according to age and ability.

WHAT TO BRING: Wear shoes and shin guards. Camp ball and water provided.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE: Players may arrive up to 30 minutes before camp begins. Parents are requested to pick up players within 30 minutes after camp ends.

INSURANCE: Get Your Kicks Soccer Camp provides secondary (back-up) medical insurance. Each player must provide primary medical coverage.
